



## **2024 Practice Management Productivity Survey Summary of Results**

- 520 individuals completed the survey, 87.5% were ASHT members
- Practice Setting
  - 42.36% hospital outpatient
  - 24.37% physician-owned practice
  - 20.12% corporate-owned practice
- Hours worked per week
  - 54.34% 31-40 hours/week
  - 24.66% >40 hours/week
- Hours spent in direct patient care
  - 54.23% 31-40 hours/week
  - 26.15% 21-30 hours/week
- Compensation method
  - 59.73% Salary
  - 35.07% Hourly
- Number of scheduled evaluations completed on average each week
  - 46.33% 1-5 evaluations
  - 41.51% 6-10 evaluations
- Number of custom orthoses fabricated each week on average
  - 46.24% 1-3 orthoses
  - 25.05% 4-6 orthoses
- Average number of unscheduled walk-ins seen each week
  - 54.42% 1-5 walk-ins/add-on patients
  - 27.12% 0 walk-ins/add-on patients
- Average frequency of visits per week once a patient is evaluated
  - 72.20% twice per week
  - 31.66% once per week
- Productivity as defined by your practice
  - 59.42% units
- Custom orthoses are included in productivity
  - 67.26% yes
