

How do I determine the cost of a custom orthosis when asked by a payer?

In order to accurately reflect the specialized clinicians' skills, time and materials involved in fabricating a custom orthosis, please consider and calculate all of the following in your estimate to the requestor. ASHT cannot give specific costs related to materials, components, labor or other time spent on the total patient experience. This will vary depending on the vendors, the contractual agreement with carriers, State regulations, various taxes, shipping, handling etc.

*Please note that all original invoices, for every component of the orthosis will most likely be requested.
